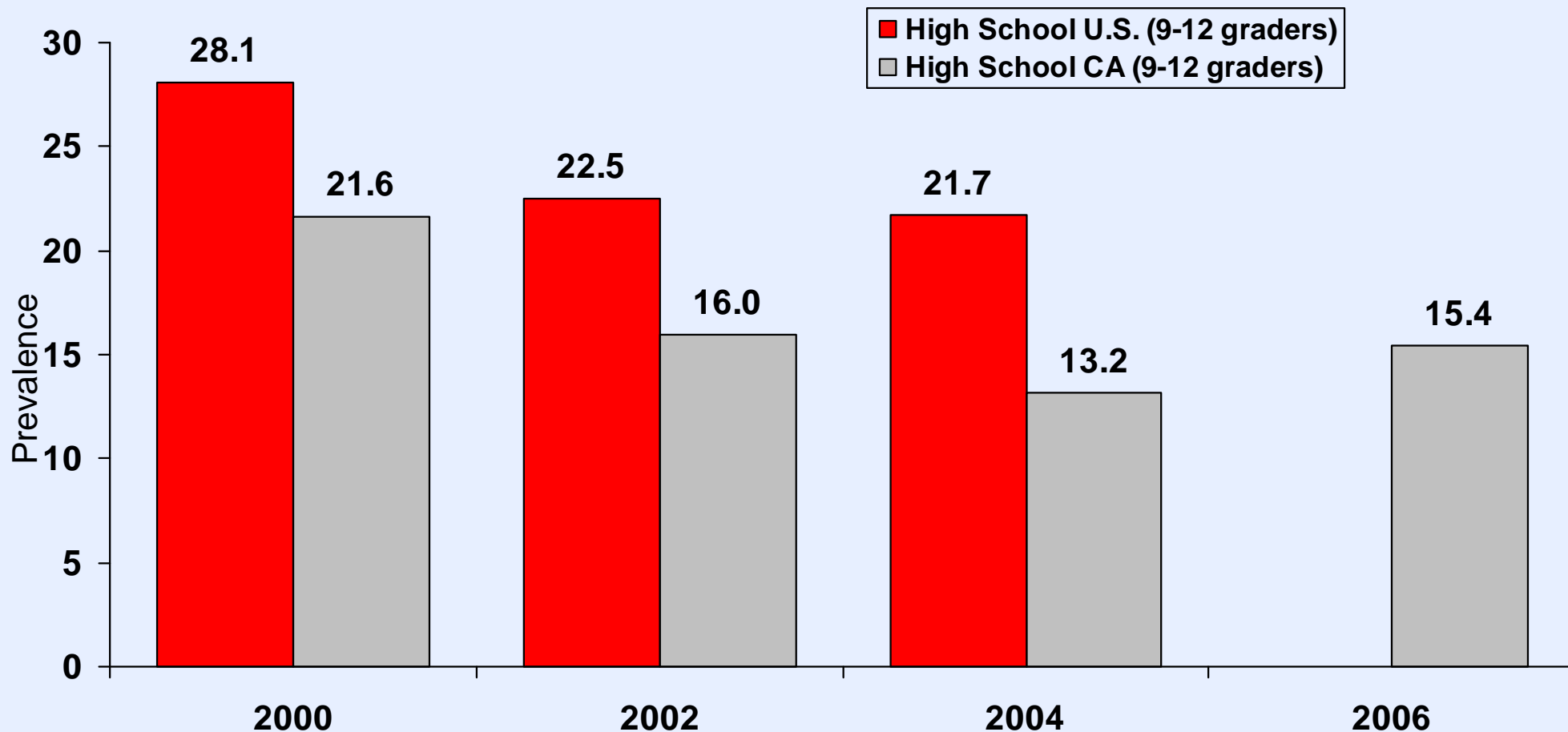


30-day Smoking Prevalence for California and United States High School (9th-12th Grade) Students, 2000-2006

The 2002, 2004, and 2006 data is from the California Student Tobacco Survey. The 2002 and 2004 data collection used active parental consent while the 2006 used a mixed parental consent procedure. The United States data is from the NYTS collected by the American Legacy Foundation and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Note that the 2006 United States data is currently unavailable.
